

How geomagnetic observatories present collected data

A b s t r a c t: Traditionally geomagnetic observatories present their data collections as the paper-printed tables and diagrams in the observatory bulletins, yearbooks, and/or monthly reports. However, this effort is time and labor consuming and expensive. In the age of modern computers, many observatories began to exploit possibilities provided by the computer media. Further, the worldwide distribution of Internet allows presentation of the observatory collections on-line. This study shows a present status of various publications and presentations from the magnetic observatories, analyzed from the responses to inquiries from Niemegk.
