Guide for authors

Authors are encouraged to submit the manuscript, in duplicate and in electronic form (floppy disc, E-mail), to the Executive Editor.

- **The manuscript** should only be written in the English language (if possible using LaTeX). The metric system should be used throughout the text. An abstract of not more than 300 words should be placed at the beginning of the paper. The title page should include the title, names of the authors and their affiliations, including the Fax number and/or E-mail address and the key words.
- **Tables** should be run in the text, numbered consecutively in Arabic numerals and provided with an appropriate caption.
- **Illustrations** should be run in the text, numbered consecutively in Arabic numerals, according to their sequence in the text. If possible, authors are encouraged to submit the illustrations in electronic form, preferably in PostScript format. Illustrations with the captions should not exceed 17.3 × 12.5 cm.
- **References** in the text should include the names of the authors (without initials), followed by the publication year in parentheses. If there are more than two authors, only the first author's name should be given in the reference, followed by "et al.":

"... as shown by *Bielik et al. (1996)* ..."

"... discussed in *Boberg et al. (2000)* and *Stacey and Banerjee (1974)* ..."

"... as proved earlier (*Pohánka, 2001; Brimich and Latynina, 1988*)..."

The following system should be used in the list of references:
